

## Junior League of San Joaquin County Mini-Grant Guidelines

Criteria:	Awarded to non-profit organizations and institutions that provide services that foster educational, vocational or life skills training for disadvantaged and/or special needs youths and their families.
Eligibility:	Any 501(c)(3) non-profits or institutions operating in San Joaquin County. Funds may not be used for administrative cost or salaries.
Award:	\$100 up to \$5,000 to be spent within one year from receipt unless otherwise requested.
Components of Application:	<ol> <li>Completed Mini-Grant Application by February 5, 2024. (see page 2).</li> <li>Limit: One application per class or organization. Incomplete applications will not be considered. Applicants will be invited to present their programs at the Junior League Mini-Grants meeting on February 17, 2024.</li> </ol>
Notification:	Grant recipients will be notified by email, and checks will be distributed approximately 1 month after approval of grant and receipt of signed Memorandum of Understanding (MOU).
	Monies received must be spent no later than end of March 2025.
Final Reports:	<ul><li>Final Report is required as documentation of your program and is due by end of March 2025.</li><li>The report may be submitted by mail or email. Please do not request a signature on delivery or an email confirmation of receipt.</li></ul>
